It's no wonder the island's rarefied legacy took hold of Ellen Kavanaugh when she transformed an expansive balcony into a cabana clubhouse with its own outside, thatch-fringed umbrella fashioned with Perennials sheers. Matting hand-woven from palm leaves

anchors rattan pieces along with low seating silhouettes straight from Mustique's fever-dream era of the late 1970s-early '80s.
